8(a) CERTIFIED

SOLE SOURCE ADVANTAGES

- ✓ **Sole-source awards above standard competitive thresholds for Tribal 8(a) firms.** Contracting officers may award sole-source contracts to tribally owned 8(a) participants above the standard 8(a) competitive thresholds. **13 CFR 124.506(b)(1)**
- ✓ **Justification and Approval (J&A) required only for higher-dollar awards.** J&A is required for sole-source awards exceeding \$25M (or \$100M for Defense), in accordance with FAR requirements. **13 CFR 124.506(b)(5); FAR 19.808-1(a); FAR 6.303; DFARS 219.808-1(a)**
- ✓ **Streamlined acquisition through direct negotiation.** The 8(a) program allows streamlined award handling, and SBA may authorize the Contracting Officer to negotiate directly with the 8(a) participant. **13 CFR 124.503; FAR 19.808-1(c)**
- ✓ **Reduced protest risk for sole-source awards.** Eligibility and size status of 8(a) participants for sole-source awards are not subject to protest, improving procurement certainty. **13 CFR 124.517(a)-(b)**
- ✓ **No standard competitive threshold cap for Tribal 8(a) sole-source awards.** Tribal 8(a) entities are exempt from the usual 8(a) competitive thresholds, allowing for larger sole-source awards with appropriate approvals. **13 CFR 124.506(b)**

WHY TRIBAL?

- ✓ Prime contractors may receive Small Business and SDB subcontracting credit for subcontracts awarded to tribally owned partners like Red Cedar TG. **FAR 19.703(c)(1)(i)**
- ✓ Indian Incentive Program (IIP) - Eligible Prime contractors may receive a 5% incentive payment for subcontracting with a tribally owned partner like Red Cedar TG. **DFARS 252.226-7001**
- ✓ Eligible firms may participate in Department of the Interior *Buy Indian* set-asides as Indian Economic Enterprises (IEE) under the *Buy Indian Act*. **25 U.S.C. 47; DIAR Part 1480.**

- ✓ Ancillary services and/or equipment are permitted when integral and necessary to the IT services-based solution. This enables integrated IT services-based solutions.
- ✓ Enables federal clients to earn SDB credit.
- ✓ Pre-competed, easy-to-use contract with streamlined ordering procedures based on **FAR 16.505**.
- ✓ No protests on orders under \$10M, except on the grounds that the order increases the scope, period, or maximum value of the GWAC.
